Subject: Service indicator reset procedure

VT Holden Commodores were fitted with a trip computer, which provides a two-mode service reminder message function to the driver. The reminder initially appears 1000Kms before the next service is due and is shown on the trip computer readout for 10 seconds whenever the vehicle ignition is switched on or off. I.e.: at 9000Kms the message 'SERV 10,000Km' will appear on the trip computer readout until the trip computer is reset.

If the vehicle is overdue for a service (i.e. the vehicle has travelled over 10,000 km) the same message 'SERV 10,000Km' will flash for 10 seconds whenever the ignition is turned on or off. In order to reset the service reminder message, the following procedure needs to be followed

- 1. Switch ignition off.
- 2. Press and hold the up and down arrow buttons simultaneously on the trip computer control panel.
- 3. Switch the ignition on while continuing to hold down both buttons
- 4. Release the buttons when a beep is sounded from the dash (reset will be flashing).
- 5. Press and hold the 'Mode' button until another beep is heard. The trip computer readout will now indicate the next scheduled service. Note: If no sound is heard release the button and press it again
- 6. Press and hold down the up and down arrow buttons until a final beep is heard.
- 7. Release both buttons, turn ignition off and then on again.
